### Wall Preparation

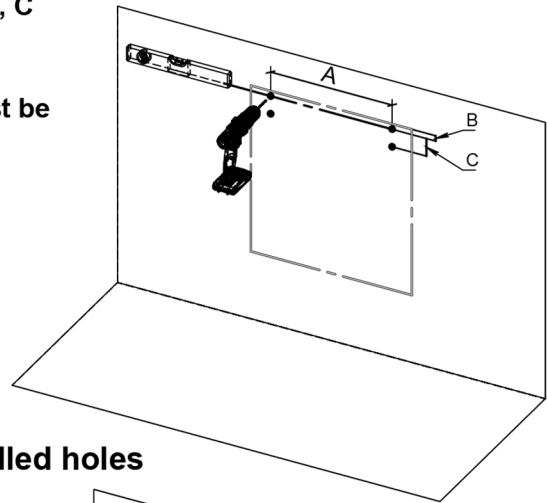
The recommended height for a console cabinet with sink is 33-1/2". This requires installing a 14" wide wood panel to a height of 34-1/4". If an alternate height desired, adjust the rough-in and backing material heights using the dimensions provided.



**STEP 1.**

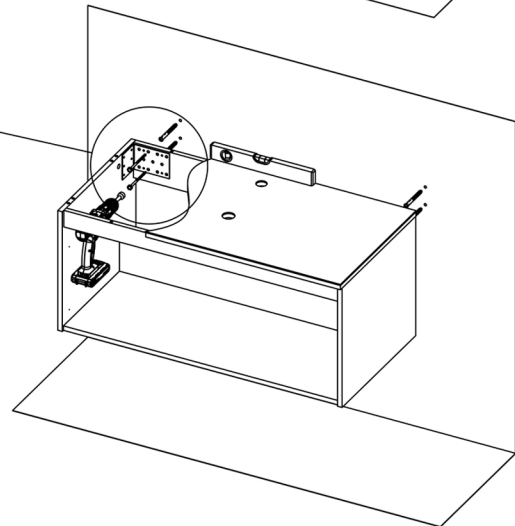
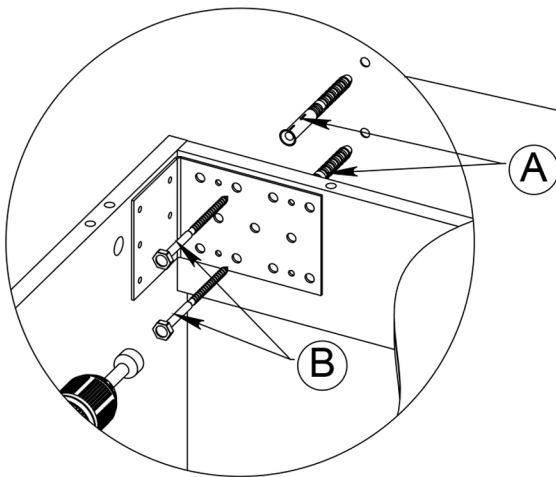
**Marking for the cabinet**  
Having decided on the location of the cabinet, we mark and drill holes in the wall measuring the distance A, B, C

Before installing the cabinet must be removed drawers.



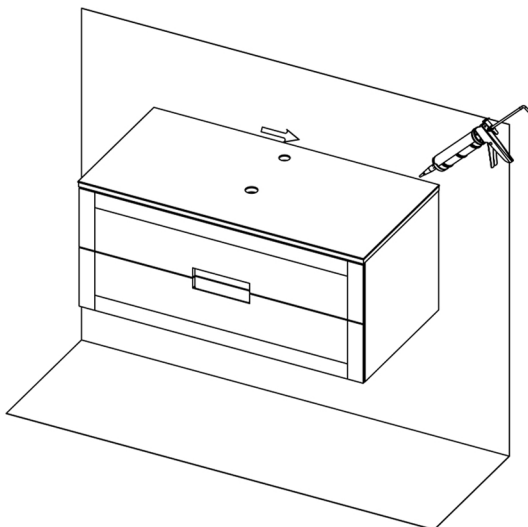
**STEP 2.**
